History of the Fourth Plinth in London's Trafalgar Square The Fourth Plinth, built in 1841, remained unused for more than 150 years. That was until the Royal Society of Arts developed the Fourth Plinth Project to celebrate all walks of modern life. In 1998 it commissioned three works for the Fourth Plinth. The first, a life-sized figure of Christ, went on display in 1999. Fourth Plinth: Recreation of ancient winged bull statue ... The second sculpture to appear on the fourth plinth in Trafalgar Square was designed by sculptor Bill Woodrow and entitled 'Regardless of History'. It shows a tree resting on a head and a book, sitting on the plinth in 2000 . The bronze weighed 11 tons and towered seven metres above the plinth. The Fourth Plinth in Trafalgar Square - London Perfect The fourth plinth was built in 1841 and was created the same size as the other northern plinth as it was intended as the base for an equestrian statue of King William IV.
